

1. INTRODUCTION

The Village Plan Group is working in association with the Parish Council to develop a 5 year plan that sets out hopes and aspirations for our community. The Plan is the vision for the future of the Parish that encompasses the whole community's views and allows people to have a greater say in their own affairs. The Plan will be presented to ELDC and will provide them with evidence of local needs and assist them in making decisions about our community.

This questionnaire has been developed following discussions and conversations we have had with many of you over the last few months and has been tested by a group of volunteers. It is your opportunity to say what is important to you.

The information collected will be analysed and presented to the community at the Annual Parish Meeting in May. It will be used to support the development of the Village Plan and will also contribute to the Emergency Plan for our community.

There is a separate questionnaire for younger residents to complete. If you have a child, or grandchild of 16 and under and think they would like to complete it then please let us know and we will provide you with a copy for them.

Guide for completing the questionnaire:

- Most of the questions have been structured so that one option per question should be selected for your answer. Where you are invited to select multiple options, this is stated with the question.
- If you don't think the question, or the available answers, apply to you then please leave the question blank. Equally, if you don't feel comfortable answering any of the questions then please leave the answer blank.
- We have also added comments boxes where we think they are needed, but you are welcome to expand on your answer on pages 15 and 16 if you wish.

Completed questionnaires will be collected on 21st/22nd April

Each person returning a completed questionnaire will be given a raffle ticket and the winner of the raffle will receive a cake and flowers that have been kindly donated by Sugar & Spice and Rosedale House Floral Designs. The raffle draw will take place at the Annual Parish Meeting in May.




