There was a male acting suspiciously in our village in the early hours of the morning.

She refused and went inside and locked the door.

He then went to another house in Church Road and rang the doorbell. The villager woke up to his dog barking. The resident did not open the door but asked who he was. He said his name was Alan from Boston and had a row with his girlfriend and but did not know where he was. Resident told him to go away and then telephoned the police.

The description was the same but this time he came with a totally different story.

Please do not open the door to anyone you do not recognise.

The Police can't emphasise enough the importance of reporting anything suspicious that

happens in our village especially in the early hours of the morning.

Any information can be used as evidence and will be logged in case anything else happens in the surrounding area.
