July was a huge month for LCC's Highways Teams. Nearly 8000 potholes repaired, hundreds of roads getting a surface treatment and many more traffic network improvements completed for the county.

### **Household Support Fund:**

Central Government has announced that the Household Support Fund will be extended for a further 6 months from 1<sup>st</sup> April. Lincolnshire will receive a further £5.5m for the fifth round of the programme which runs until 30<sup>th</sup> September 2024. As with earlier rounds of funding, LCC has worked with District Councils to decide how this additional funding is most effectively targeted to Lincolnshire residents most in need.

In Lincolnshire, more than 17% of people have high blood pressure. But 6 million people in the UK don't know they have it and there are often no symptoms.
