Burglaries in Surrounding Areas.

We are having several burglaries at remote locations around the Wolds Area between Burgh Le Marsh, Louth and Horncastle.
Unknown persons have gained access by removing locks.
Items stolen are Batteries, Petrol, Power Tools, Pressure Washers and Diesel.

Attempted Burglary on a Barn. Owners returned home and disturbed offenders. They left leaving behind a Bolt Cropper and a Jerry Bar. Nothing stolen.

A 21ft Boat on a Trailer was stolen from Boston Road, Spilsby.

Dwelling burglary late morning / early afternoon Main Road, Toynton All Saints.

Attempts to use forged £20 and £50 notes at Post Offices, Public Houses and Eating Establishments.

Persons appeared to have Irish connections and possibly driving vehicles on Irish Registration Plates.

There have been several burglaries on the entire Policing Area but they are all Commercial against Businesses.
